Family Services

Programs range from supplemental foods and nutrition counseling to intensive home-based assistance and family planning services. Our programs work in collaboration, ensuring that families receive services with a common goal of promoting and strengthening each family by providing the foundation upon which families can flourish.

HopeCare Clinic

The clinic is open to the public and serves adolescents, men and women of reproductive age. It is staffed by a nurse practitioner who performs routine medical exams and tests for both men and women, such as annual exams; and testing, treatment, and counseling for sexually transmitted infections.

For women, pap smears, breast exams, birth control and emergency contraception are also available; along with pregnancy testing and counseling; and testing/ treatment for urinary tract and vaginal infections.

Insurance and Medicaid are accepted, and no referral is required. There are two locations, in Jeffersonville and Scottsburg. Appointments may be scheduled by calling 812-288-1223.



WIC – Women, Infants and Children WIC is a federallyfunded nutrition

funded nutrition program that provides supplemental food, nutrition counseling, and community referrals to pregnant, breastfeeding, and postpartum women, infants and children under five years of age. WIC is designed to improve fetal



development, reduce the incidence of low birth weight and premature births, reduce maternal and childhood anemia, and promote breast feeding.

Healthy Families

This program is a voluntary and confidential home-based service to support new and expectant parents. Because babies begin learning at birth, Healthy Families believes parents are their child's first and best teachers. Parenting is a very demanding job and all parents have worries, questions and stress. Families receive regular visits from a trained family support specialist who can provide support, developmental assessments for their child, and an opportunity to set and accomplish family goals.

Ability Services

Our programs work with adults with disabilities and their families, helping them to increase vocational and employment skills, adult daily living skills, community integration, self care, and household duties in order to increase independence.

ACES – Adult Community Empowerment Services

ACES provides an activity-related, facility-based day program for adults with developmental disabilities to promote community and social integration. This program teaches and supports individuals in accessing their community, and promotes social skills and activities while participating in community events.

Community Habilitation

This program provides purposeful, goal-oriented activities for adults of any age with disabilities. All services are intended to help clients reach their highest level of independence regarding personal, social, and daily living skills.

Job and Skills Training

The Job Training Center offers a training program that teaches job skills. This may include collating for printing companies, labeling, and small hand assembly. These programs provide personal, social, educational, daily living, and community integration skills which can translate into full or part-time jobs for clients.

Supported Living

Offers services for the specific needs of up to four individuals in an apartment or family home. Some may only need a few hours of assistance a week; others may require 24-hour care. This external support allows them to live as independently as possible, yet be safe and secure.

Behavior Management

Supports individuals to use positive strategies to decrease the occurrence of behaviors, helping them to increase independence and meaningful participation in the community, which enhances their quality of life.

Respite Care/Attendant Care/Homemaker

Provides temporary or periodic care for a person with disabilities, to provide relief for the usual care giver. Activities include assistance with meal preparation, daily living skills, grooming, administration of medications, and assistance with accessing the community. Offers flexible scheduling.

Employment Services

Assists individuals in selecting, obtaining and/or maintaining appropriate employment in competitive settings, consistent with individual needs and interest. Most importantly, we help individuals with developmental, physical, and emotional disabilities realize their maximum potential within integrated community work settings.



Independence

Integration

Supports clients to live successfully in their own homes, as well as function and participate in their communities. Activities include: daily living, self-care, and mobility skills to help ensure their health, safety and welfare, as well as increase their independence at home.

Participant Assistance and Care (PAC)

Wellness Coordination Services

Provide development, maintenance, and routine monitoring of a client's Wellness Coordination Plan and the medical services required to manage his/her health care needs. These services are provided by an RN, or an LPN supervised by an RN.

Housing & Community Development



Our Housing & Community Development team works to provide direction and leadership in the development of safe, affordable and suitable housing in response to public need.

Over the past 22 years New Hope has constructed single-family homes and multi-family and senior living communities in Jeffersonville and several other locations in Indiana, including Scottsburg, Elwood and Clinton.

Today New Hope is expanding at some properties as well as developing new ones in order to help meet the increasing demand for affordable housing in Indiana.
